

2023 Medigap Plan G Rates

Description

Comparing 2023 Medigap Plan G rates is a wise thing to do since the costs can vary considerably from one company to another, even though the coverage and the way the plans work is identical.



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As indicated by the bombardment of TV commercials and spam phone calls and mail, we are coming up on the Medicare Annual Election Period (AEP). Although this time period actually does not pertain to Medigap plans in any way (you can sign up for, or change, Medigap at any time of the year), it is a common time for comparing Medigap rates and making sure you still have the best available deal.

The rates for Plan G are different in different parts of the country, and they can even vary, with some companies, in each zip code. Rates are also different for different ages (i.e. some companies have lower rates for 65 year olds vs. others that have lower rates in older ages). There is no "one size fits all" approach to choosing a Plan G.
